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








Hobbies






Time Spent on Hobbies




Above are the hours spent doing my hobbies per day, month, and year.






Future Plans










Family Fun

Chocolate Chip Cookies


Ingredients

- 2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 cup (2 sticks) unsalted butter, room temperature
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 1 cup packed light-brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- 2 large eggs
- 2 cups (about 12 ounces) semisweet and/or milk chocolate chips



Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a small bowl, whisk together the flour and baking soda; set aside. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, combine the butter with both sugars; beat on medium speed until light and fluffy. Reduce speed to low; add the salt, vanilla, and eggs. Beat until well mixed, about 1 minute. Add flour mixture; mix until just combined. Stir in the chocolate chips.
- 2. Drop heaping tablespoon-size balls of dough about 2 inches apart on baking sheets lined with parchment paper.
- 3. Bake until cookies are golden around the edges, but still soft in the center, 8 to 10 minutes. Remove from oven, and let cool on baking sheet 1 to 2 minutes. Transfer to a wire rack, and let cool completely. Store cookies in an airtight container at room temperature up to 1 week.



True Team State

For the first time in Foley history, the 2014 swim and dive team advanced to the True Team State meet at the University of Minnesota pool. Swimming at the U of M pool was a big accomplishment for many of the girls on the team. Normally state meets are just for individuals tat advance so it was cool to have to have the whole team participate in a state level meet. Out of the 12 teams that competed, Foley took 10th place.

As for myself, I was in 3 relays which helped get points for the team. In the 200 medley relay I swam the anchor spot, a 50 free, and got a personal best time of 28.95. The 200 freestyle relay I got a 29.64 in my part of the race. My last relay, the 400 freestyle relay, my time stayed consistent and was a 1:10.83. It was my last meet of the year so it was a good ending not for me.
